We will inform parents which groups of students have materials to be secured from the school. Back to School Night will also be held virtually this year. The dates are September 17<sup>th</sup> from 6-8PM for all Middle School students and September 24<sup>th</sup> from 6-8PM for all High School Students. Further information will be emailed on September 8<sup>th</sup> and will be available on the website the same day.

Many parents inquired about tutoring and their student's schedule. All student class schedules will be available in the Parent/Student Portal on August 31<sup>st</sup>. Parents, please make sure that you are registered and have access to the Parent Portal prior to August 31<sup>st</sup>. Students may use their same login information to access their schedules. If you are not new to AACPS and forgot your password, please follow the directions on the Parent Portal website. AACPS will be offering free tutoring for all students. Information is forthcoming. We at CSP will also offer tutoring. Teachers will share information via their class syllabus and Google Classroom.
